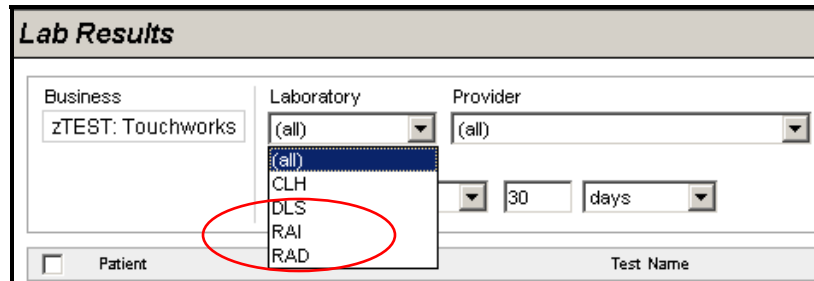


## Enterprise EHR Documentation: Radiology Result Reporting

### Radiology Result Reporting Overview

Enterprise EHR is now interfaced to Radiology Associates/Acculmaging (RAI) and Queen's Medical Center Imaging Services (RAD), allowing you to receive text radiology result reports electronically. As with your DLS and CLH lab results, radiology reports are transmitted electronically into ConnxtMD. Any reports that do not automatically match to an existing patient must be manually linked in Electronic Lab Results. RAI and RAD have been added to the Laboratory dropdown to allow for easy filtering of results:



Once linked, reports flow over to Enterprise and are tasked to the physician for verification.

There are a few functional differences with the radiology reports:

- Only reports ordered by the physician are transmitted. Carbon copy (cc) reports are not transmitted.
- You may not view the report in ConnxtMD. The report may only be viewed in Enterprise.
- Only text report results interface to Enterprise. Images can be retrieved using your current process.
- Text results interface into Enterprise as an annotation. Enterprise does not include annotations when a lab result is cited into a note. However, you may copy and paste text from the annotation tab into a note.

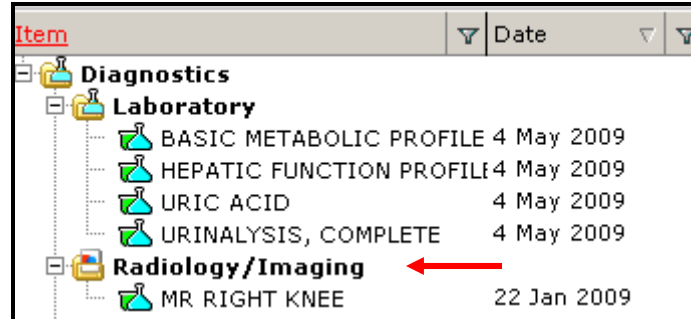
### In Enterprise: Results Tab

Text results appear on the results tab and are verified the same way as your existing lab reports.

## How to Get Your Radiology Reports Electronically

- 1) You must be a ConnxtMD customer. Radiology result reports are not available for Misys customers.
- 2) Your authorization is required for us to interface electronic reports. Download and complete the Radiology Associates/Acculmaging authorization form and/or the QMC Imaging authorization form from our website, [www.teampraxis.com](http://www.teampraxis.com) (go to Help Desk, Enterprise EHR). You can enroll for both radiology lab interfaces or just one.
- 3) Return the completed form via fax to TW Support at 949-0483. We will handle all setup and notify you when your practice has been activated.
- 4) Once you are live, if you get a hard copy radiology report without a corresponding electronic report, please notify our Help Desk. Remember to check ConnxtMD first for unlinked reports.
- 5) To discontinue hard copy reports in the future, please contact the radiology labs directly.
